



CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct identifies the standard of behavior that is expected of all Clarington Minor Lacrosse Association members, (here after referred to as CMLA) including athletes, coaches, parents and volunteers.

The CMLA is committed to providing a sports environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members of CMLA shall conduct themselves in a fair and responsible manner at all times. Members shall refrain from any comments or behavior, which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, CMLA shall not tolerate any behavior that constitutes harassment or abusive. During the course of all CMLA activities (including but not limited to games) and events, members shall avoid behavior that brings CMLA or its sponsors or community partners or the sport into disrepute, including but not limited to abusive use of alcohol or non-medical use of drugs.

All athletes shall cooperate with their coaches, leaders, teammates and encourage one another to perform well for the club. All members of CMLA shall respect the privilege of the use of public facilities that may be used for club events or activities or competition. No member of CMLA shall engage in any act of vandalism of the public facilities that may be used for club events or activities or competition.

Failure to comply with this code of behavior may result in disciplinary action as determined for the CMLA executive.
